**Job description :**

- participation to a longitudinal study on inter- and intra-individual variability in cognitive aging, within a lifespan perspective
- administration of various cognitive tasks to the study participants
- coordination of data collection and analyses, supervision of student helpers
- redaction of publications and of communications in international conferences

The position is to begin on January 1, 2012. The contract can be established for up to 33 months. Starting salary is approximately 65'000.- SFR (70%).

**Requirements:**

- PhD in psychology, and post-doctoral research experience
- very good knowledge of, and preferably experience in, cognitive aging research
- good training in quantitatively-oriented psychology, advanced methodological skills and experience in multivariate data analyses, good computer knowledge, in particular with software such as E-Prime and SPSS
- working environment is in French (in particular, experimentation in French) ; good English skills are required
